CHURCH HISTORY

In July 1986, Thomas J. Hertweck, his wife Eunhee, and children Lisa, David and Joshua returned to New York State after graduating from Central Bible College and the Assemblies of God Theological Seminary in Springfield, Missouri.

The New York District of the Assemblies of God asked the Hertweck's to plant a new church in Liverpool, New York. The church met in the NY District Office building at 8130 Oswego Road, Liverpool.

After one month of preparation, Trinity Assembly of God's first service was held on Sunday, August 24, 1986. Twenty-five people from the community attended and TAG had its beginning!

On July 20, 1987, needing more space for the growing congregation, TAG began meeting at the Wetzel Road Elementary School, 4246 Wetzel Road, Liverpool. On September 14, 1988, TAG became a General Council Affiliated (Sovereign) church. On October 4, 1988, TAG received its Certificate of Incorporation. At this time TAG was averaging seventy-five in attendance.

In 1991, TAG purchased six acres of land at 4398 Route 31, the site of TAG's new church building.

On January 1, 1995, there was a powerful visitation of the Holy Spirit. It was a "suddenly" from God that launched TAG in a new and fresh way. Many in the church body were powerfully touched, healed and empowered for ministry!

In April 1997, we moved into the brand new 9,110 square foot church building on Route 31 in Clay, NY. Our church council at this time were; John Bowers, Kevin DeMarco, Lynda Jordan, and Luis Gonzalez as a Deacon.

In May 1999, due to growth, the following people were added to the church staff; Elaine Bell as church secretary, Barb Gonzalez as financial secretary, Eunhee Hertweck as Co-Pastor and Administrator, and David Hertweck as Associate Pastor with a focus in Youth Ministry & Worship.

In 1999 the Lamb & Lion missions ministry was formed. In 1999, two trips were made to Belize, Central America. In 2000, trips were made to Ecuador and Spain. In 2001, a team went to Guyana, South America. In 2002, trips were made to the Dominican Republic and Trinidad. Between the years of 2003–2016, the following countries were visited for missions, Cuba, Northern Ireland, England, Mexico, Italy, South Korea and Israel.

In August 2005, we moved into our 7,000 square foot all-purpose building, debt free!

In 2011, Pastor David Hertweck was led by God to move into the position of NY District Youth Director with the Assemblies of God, so he stepped down from his position at TAG. At that time, Andy Henderson became the Youth Leader. Jason Foster took over the role of Youth Leader in 2016.

In November 2011, Victoria Foster was installed as our Children's Pastor. She serves on staff with Pastors Tom & Eunhee. Vicki DeMarco is the Financial Secretary for TAG and our current (2016) council members are; John Bowers, Ralph DeMarzo, Jason Foster, Robbin Guiles, and Lynda Jordan. The deacons are; Kevin DeMarco, Derek Henderson, and Gary Houghton.

God has been faithful to His people through Trinity Assembly of God; and we look forward to seeing a revival in this land and having multiple church services on Sunday mornings! We pray that He will continue to allow us to spread the gospel through missions, home and foreign, through giving and going. All glory to Him!
